### **HEALTH & HYGIENE CAMP - SHAHEENBAGH**

**Dated 7<sup>th</sup> Apr 2017: 11 am to 2 pm**

#### **Background:**

Basic health needs are not available to poor slum people in Shaheenbagh & Okhla area, New Delhi. Incidence of diseases like Malaria, Viral Fever, Various Skin Infections, and malnutrition rates are high. Many people do not have awareness about health and hygiene. We will provide healthcare and health education to poor slum dwellers. People with Malaria, Skin Infections suffer from its effects over their entire lifetime. These develops into chronic conditions, leads to body deformities, and increased medical expenses.

#### **Objective**

The main objective of the exercise is to create awareness about the most prominent and serious health concerns that are aggravating in our population, such as diabetes, cardiovascular disease, and high blood pressure. We have conducted awareness campaigns on health and personal hygiene benefiting a total of around more than 400+ people. The medical camps were particularly oriented to the slum dwellers of Shram Vihar, Shaheenbagh & Okhla in the past Month & a Half which are the most vulnerable to diseases & Unawareness.

Around 40+ Patients were Seen on 7<sup>th</sup> April in Shaheenbagh & Okhla suffering from Cold, Cough, Fever , Various Skin Infections ,Respiratory Issues , Hygiene Issues & Other General Problem.

Women patient were informed about the Health & hygiene of themselves as well as their Children's. Pregnant Women were informed about the Benefits of medication during pregnancy Lactation. Proper Counseling was done for what to be done & what not to be done during Pregnancy. Majority of Patients Were Children under the age of 10 years. Medicines were also provided.
